Background

The Medford Lakes Colony Summer Camp – or just simply “Camp” – began in 1929. Utilizing the beaches, lakes, playground and the Pinelands, in which the town was originally build, Camp essentially takes place within Medford Lakes proper.

In its early years, most residents of Medford Lakes were only seasonal and Camp was an ALL-DAY EVENT that ran from July 4th to Labor Day! Wow!

The aspiration of the Extended Hours Program is to offer children and grandchildren of Colonists the opportunity to experience a longer day at Camp.

Locations

The Extended Hours Program will be held at ...

- (a.) Vaughan Hall,
- (b.) Beach #1 and
- (c.) the Craft Pavilion & Brooks Field

Daily Schedule

The Extended Hours Program will rotate similar to the schedules of Lower and Upper Camp, but will be mostly confined to Vaughan Hall, Beach #1 and the Craft Pavilion (& Brooks Field) [subject to change].

The day will start at 1:30 pm, at the conclusion of Lower Camp and Upper Camp, at the Craft Pavilion.

At the Craft Pavilion, Campers will meet with their designated Senior Counselors and enjoy a small snack. The groups – A, B and C – will then disperse at the discretion of the Program’s Director.

Groups A, B and C will disperse as follows:

Group A: Beach #1

Group B: Vaughan Hall

Group C: Craft Pavilion (& Brooks Field)

At 6:00 pm, Campers will be dismissed in reference to their parent/guardians’ “Dismissal Preferences.”

**If there is to be either a parent/guardian or friend/parent pick-up, please be advised that the Colony will be enforcing a fee for late pick-ups (after 6:00 pm) - \$10.00 for the first minute and \$1.00 for every minute after. Do not be considered late!

Any changes MUST be discussed in advance with the Program’s Director!

Inclement Weather

The Extended Hours Program is planned to run rain or shine. If Lower Camp and Upper Camp are both cancelled for the day, Extended Hours is still a go!

Campers will need to bring a packed lunch – preferably without any peanut/tree-nut products – and additional snacks and drinks with them, and they have to be prepared for outdoor activities.
