COLONY MEMBERSHIP

Every child or grandchild, who lives in a household that pays Medford Lakes Colony dues, and is age appropriate, has the opportunity to attend any of our summer camp programs. **However, to attend the Medford Lakes Colony Summer Camp’s “Extended Hours” Program, every eligible child or grandchild must be registered for either Lower or Upper Camp (i.e. Grades 1 – 8).

The current year dues must be paid at the regular rate of membership for any child / grandchild to attend camp [refer to “Medford Lakes Colony Rules and Regulations” – Page 6 (refer to next paragraph) – “Nonresident participation in Colony activities Summer Camp”].

“Medford Lakes Colony Rules and Regulations,” Page 6: “... (3) ‘Summer Camp: Nonresident grandchildren of members may participate in the summer camp program if the children reside (sleep overnight) in the grandparent’s home for the term of the program. Such campers must wear a guest tag while attending camp. If the members qualify for the senior citizen or over 65 annual fee categories, they must pay the difference in the Annual fees between such category and the regular category, in addition to the camp fee, when they register their grandchildren for camp.”

SIBLING DISCOUNT

At the time of registration: BEGINNING WITH THE SECOND CHILD, a 20.0% discount will be applied for every enrolled child from the same household with Colony membership.

PAYMENT

Similarly, to our Summer Camp Program, “Extended Hours” will run for 4 weeks in the month of July. However, its registration process and cost(s) are completely unique and separate. Please be aware that the program’s cost is NOT based on the particular number of days and / or hours that your child or grandchild may be attending, but rather for the entire duration of the program.

We accept checks and money orders made payable to the “Medford Lakes Colony.”

LATE PICK-UP FEE

The fee(s) for a late pick-up, after the end of the “Extended Hours” Program, is **\$10.00 for the first minute and \$1.00 for every minute after.** PLEASE, do not be considered late!

PROGRAM WITHDRAWALS

This is a Member’s Only Program – please contact the Colony Office if you are uncertain if your child is eligible to attend our Summer Camp and / or Extended Hours Program.

**** Refunds will be issued for a child unable to attend our Summer Camp and / or Extended Hours Program due to a medical reason – a Doctor’s Note will be required!**

** All other refunds must be approved by Camp Council.

INCLEMENT WEATHER / CAMP CLOSINGS / EARLY DISMISSALS

(I.) The Medford Lakes Colony Camp’s Extended Hours Program is scheduled to run rain or shine. If Lower Camp and Upper Camp are both canceled for the day due to inclement weather, etc., the

Extended Hours Program is still a go! The Extended Hours Program will run a full day from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM, *instead* of its normally scheduled hours-of-operation from 1:30 PM to 6:00 PM. Please be advised, for these days, a packed lunch with a drink – preferably one without any peanut / tree-nut products – and additional snacks must be brought with your child(ren).

(II.) “Extended Hours” were to be “closed” for the day, the parent / guardian will be contacted. Alternatively, messages will be send from “Remind,” a free app that helps teachers, students and parents communicate quickly and efficiently. To join “Remind,” please text @mltexts to 81010.

(III.) If a parent / guardian needs to arrange for an early dismissal, a note must be provided to the Program’s Director. The note will specify the date(s), time(s) and reason(s) for the early dismissal.
