RESULTS OF ELECTION

The results of October 28th's election are as follows:

In the matter of the dues increase with installment payment options, the vote was:

204 in favor and 186 opposed. That vote carried.

In the matter of the Board's authority to enact cost-of-living increases up to 2.5%, the vote was:

146 in favor and 242 opposed. That vote failed.

Understandably, this was a contentious issue with strong feelings on both sides, which was reflected in the narrow vote. This was a situation that no one wanted. For those who supported the board's recommendation for increased dues, we sincerely appreciate your trust and will prove to you that we deserved it. For those who opposed our recommendation, we know that we must work to earn your trust and will work hard to do so.

GOT SNEAKERS?

7th Grade Girl Scout Troop #24315 is collecting gently used or new adult sneakers. When you join our sneaker recycling community, you will be making a global impact AND you help troop earn money for every pair of sneakers you contribute.

Most people throw away their used sneakers every 125-200 days without ever thinking about recycling. Since sneakers are manufactured with materials that are not biodegradable, they remain in landfills or are incinerated, which leads to toxic chemicals in our air and soil.

The process of manufacturing sneakers produces large amounts of CO2 which contributes to the serious effects of climate change and global warming. Recycling and reusing sneakers keeps sneakers out of landfills, reduces the need for manufacturing new shoes and sneakers, and supports a growing circular economy.
