ATTENTION YOUNG WOMEN **GRADUATING SHAWNEE** MARKETA MCCABE SCHOLARSHIP

Marketa was a Medford Lakes resident studying civil and environmental engineering at Rowan University. She strongly advocated for greater representation of women and minority groups in STEM fields. Cardiac arrhythmia tragically caused Marketa's heart to stop in her sleep on March 13, 2021. She was almost 20 years old. In honor of her legacy, Marketa's Journey, Inc., a non-profit organization, was created to provide scholarships for young women interested in pursuing STEM, particularly those interested in engineering or environmental studies. To date, Marketa's Journey has awarded almost \$10,000 in scholarships, donated \$1,450 to local organizations, and contributed 410 hours of volunteer time. She was so good at making friends. She found a new home. And, as was one of her many gifts, she soon helped others do the same. She loved doing that.

She was there for the founding of The Flyers Wives Fight for Lives. It raised millions of dollars for those battling leukemia. She did this and you may not have known that.

She joined a Canoe Carnival float group, The Baker's Dozen. She gave birth to two boys, maybe you know them as well. She earned a Master's Degree. She kept her hair long. She loved Yanni. She learned to play pickleball and mahjong. She loved her dock and her yard and her lake and so very many of you. She never knew exactly where Beach 5 was. She was happy. She was tough. She had too many sneakers. She left us too soon.

She had that kind of smile, you know? The kind that changes weather. She gave those kinds of hugs that made it all alright. We miss her so very very much. She was extraordinary.

And while she is no longer with all of us, there are a few things we believe she would want to pass along. It's hard to be good. It's worth it. Dance when you can. You're probably bad at it. Who cares. Always find a way to forgive.

And finally, thank you. Medford Lakes is not just a place to live. It is a life. It is a wonderful gorgeous life. Please never lose sight of that.
