

#### WATCH THE ICE

If you ever venture onto a frozen pond or lake, you should do so with extreme caution. Even during periods of very cold weather, ice can crack and cause you or your child to fall into the icy water.

Icy water is very different from the water you swim in during the summer. It is extremely dangerous, as it prevents your body from functioning properly

Never skate without first checking to make sure the ice is at least 6 inches thick. Ice thickness is not uniform across a body of water. Always check the thickness of the ice in more than one area.

Never skate on a pond or lake by yourself. Use the buddy system and bring a friend!

There should also be someone watching from solid ground.

If the ice does crack, drop to your hands and knees and crawl off the ice. This helps distribute your weight more widely, while reducing your chances of falling through the ice.

Educating yourself on ice safety and what to do in ice emergencies is a critical step in staying safe on the ice. If you are unsure of conditions, it is best to refrain from any ice activities - if in doubt, don't go out! (https://preventionworks-nj.org/news-and-events/safety-frozen-lake-or-pond)

#### BOROUGH ORDINANCE § 185-13FEEDING WATERFOWL.

[Added 8-1-1988 by Ord. No. 249]

It shall be unlawful for any person to:

- A. Feed any waterfowl.
- B. Create any condition, or allow any condition to exist, which results in a congregation or congestion of waterfowl which:
  - (1) Results in an accumulation of waterfowl feces or droppings; or
  - (2) Results in damage to flora, fauna, or private or public property; or
  - (3) Results in a threat to the public health, safety or welfare; or
  - (4) Results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of said waterfowl.

#### § 185-14 Violations and penalties.

[Amended 4-23-2014 by Ord. No. 615]

Any person, firm, corporation, association or legal party whatsoever who or which shall violate, or authorize or procure a violation, or cause to be violated, any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable as provided under the general penalty provisions found at § 1-15 of this Code. This, however, shall not apply against any municipal employee or officer that authorizes action by permit or otherwise in the ordinary course of their duties.


